WIRE-BRUSHED RIFT WHITE OAK

All of our finishes on White Oak within the Luxury Collection are wire brushed to add texture and accentuate the natural grain patterns of the wood. Wire brushing is a process that involves hand-scraping the oak with a metal brush to reveal the soft grain from the growth ring of the tree. What becomes exposed after this process is the heart of the wood (hardwood) which results in a finish that has exceptional grain characteristics and appears weathered and distressed.

SANDBLASTED CHERRY

For our Weathered and Desert Gray finishes on Cherry, we use a highly specialized process called sand-blasting to accentuate the grain and add character and texture. The process is accomplished by blasting extremely fine particulates of sand at the cherry, which darkens the wood but leaves behind natural blond highlights. Once the stain is applied, the end result is a one of a kind finish of unrivaled beauty and luxury.

Superior Construction

Every cabinet we produce is certified Carb 2 compliant and built to the highest specification possible to ensure durability and longevity. Our standard all-wood box construction features premium 9-ply plywood for structural integrity, squareness and precision. As an added bonus, almost every part of our cabinet is edge-banded and laminated, including the tops, sides and bottoms to reduce warping and the harmful effects of water.

Supreme Storage

Our full access, frameless construction maximizes storage and accessibility in the kitchen. Because our cabinetry does not have a frame that protrudes into the cabinet opening, the interior is readily accessible which makes storing large platters, cookware and plates easy. While most wall cabinets are manufactured 12" deep, our wall cabinets are 13" deep as a standard to provide even more storage for larger household items.

Our shelves are crafted from solid 3/4" plywood which is edge-banded on all four sides and then finished with a sophisticated European style front edge. In addition to being aesthetically unique, each shelf we manufacture is designed with stability in mind and features our ever-lock system. This system utilizes stainless steel shelf clips that lock into pre-drilled holes that are bored into the bottom of the shelf to prevent movement and ensure the sturdiness of the shelf and overall structure of the cabinet.
